Key issues

local procurement & import replacement; education & awareness; partnerships & collaboration across sectors; capacity and potential of local food processing facilities

Opportunities to explore

local food movement & investment, e.g. community economic development investment funds; branding/marketing; food security; adding value through technology; developing export markets

Strong points

network of local suppliers; land availability; passion and expertise; strong network of R&D agencies and institutions supporting innovation and productivity improvements in agri-food

Weak points & threats

government regulations & barriers to growth; internal "can't do" attitude; lack of co-operation & communication within sector; labour supply (shortage); limited processing facilities; lack of public awareness re: value of local agriculture

Proposed actions in 2017

Create "buy local" awareness campaign supported by evidence, promoting economic and social benefits.

Assess capacity and potential in local food processing facilities; promote opportunities for business development & investment.

Through partnerships, coordinate workshops & training sessions to support knowledge-sharing; facilitate discussion about Valley branding.

THE SECTOR TABLE WORKSHOP

On Dec. 7, the Valley REN hosted a workshop in Kentville with more than 60 people from five key sectors in the Annapolis Valley: agriculture, tourism, information and communications technologies (ICT), manufacturing, and sustainable energy.

Our facilitator, Common Good Solutions, led the five "sector tables" in a SWOT analysis.
