

Digital Nova Scotia has officially launched its **Skills For Hire** (skillsforhire.ca) programs in collaboration with Bluedrop Learning Networks and Employment and Social Development Canada.

There are 3 main course paths for participants: [Web Design and Development](#), [User Experience](#), and [Cyber Security](#). Our programs are intended to help fill the need for qualified talent in the tech sector and is free to residents of Nova Scotia and Newfoundland & Labrador who are at least 18 years old and hold a high school diploma or GED. Courses are delivered through online learning.

All 3 programs also offer additional training in job search and workplace productivity skills, as well as a virtual career kickstarter workshop.

The programs are self-guided online with a series of scheduled interactions including an orientation session and 3 professional development workshops, and 1 employer panel with subject matter experts. All programs are designed to be completed within 6-10 weeks.
