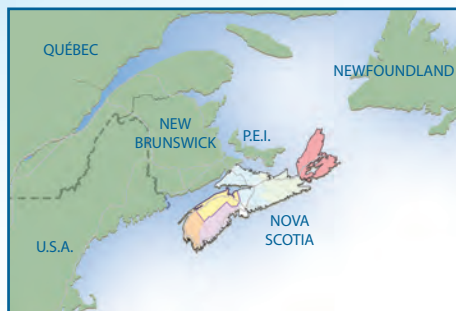

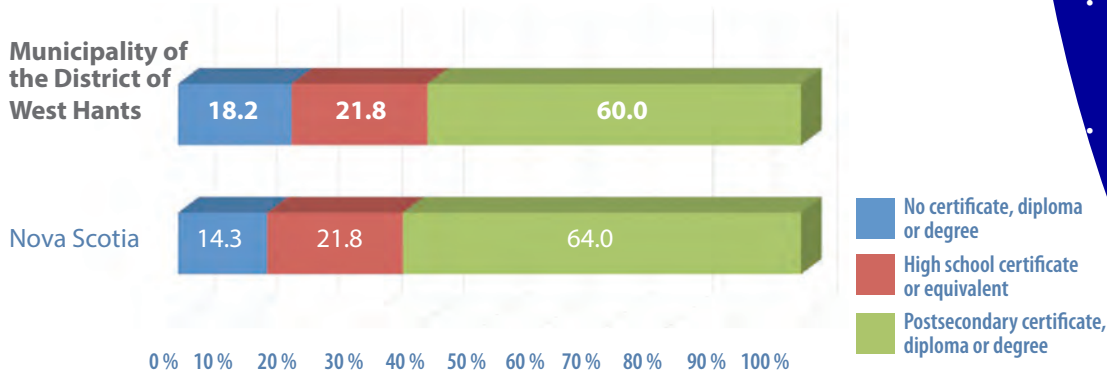

- West Hants is strategically located along the shores of the Minas Basin at the entrance to the Annapolis Valley and is less than an hour's drive to Halifax

- The Municipality possesses a strong sense of community and high levels of volunteerism.
- Major local industries include Construction, Retail trade, Health care & social assistance and Manufacturing
- Agriculture and farming is an important contributor to the economy of West Hants, and boasts a growing wine industry
- The Municipality is home to a vibrant local economy with indicators placing it on par with Nova Scotia averages
- West Hants is part of the Valley Community Fiber Network, a high-capacity telecommunications backbone spanning 200 kilometers
- For potential industrial opportunities, the area has excellent water supply and municipal services
